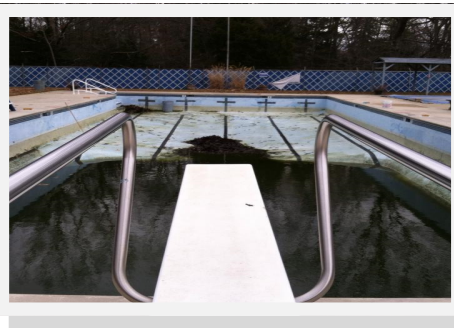
The Pool will not be available to swimmers until 12 pm Monday thru Friday during the swim team season.

Members Only Perk: Guidelines for Booking a Party

Active members that are *up-to-date with their membership dues* may make a reservation to host a party at the Swim Club. Booking Member Parties such as birthday parties requires prior approval through our social committee. A written request must be submitted along with a \$40.00 non-refundable fee. Party reservation times are as follows: Monday – Friday 12 pm to 4 pm and 4:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Saturday and Sunday 1 pm to 4 pm and 5 pm to 8 pm. Please note only one par-

ty may be scheduled during any given time frame. Also no parties may be scheduled during Special Events or Swim Meets. Each party must also pay a \$40.00 fee for a second lifeguard. Once your written request has been submitted you will receive confirmation of your date and it will be posted on the calendar in the kitchen. Please be sure to follow the special events procedures posted at the pool. Since the pool will remain open to the general members, we enforce a four

table maximum limit for party use to ensure ample table space for members.

Any member belonging to an organization wishing to book a pool party must pay a \$150.00 party fee as well as the \$40.00 fee for a second lifeguard. For more information on booking a party, please contact Gina Scotti.

A Friendly Reminder on our Guest Policy & Membership...

Members are required to sign all guests in the sign in book. Only adult members may sign in no more than 10 free guests per season. When this quota is used up, each guest will be charged \$5 per person, per admission. If a pool member under the age of 18 brings a guest, each guest must pay \$5.00 and there is a limit of 2 guests per day. All guests must be accompa-

nied by a member over 10 years of age, and must sign in with the lifeguard upon arrival to pay for their fee. When the pool member leaves the guest must leave as well. Guests must observe pool rules and the member is responsible for the conduct of the guest. Please note it is the Lifeguards discretion to allow children under 10 to bring a guest.

Feel free to contact any of the board members should you have any questions on our guest policy.

Any member wishing to resign their membership must offer it for sale in writing PRIOR to January 1st of the upcoming season or annual dues will be assessed to your account and deducted from the redemption amount due.
